Players can choose to take part in improvisation, playing places by using images, soundpainting or sound massages, to name but a few. The workshops are led by members of the ensemble KNM Berlin. There is also a Call for Pieces for composers: several submitted works will be rehearsed by KNM players in workshops and two will be performed in Saturday evening.

The event will take place in the very centre of Berlin and opens with a concert by the professional ensemble KNM Berlin on Thursday evening. The following two days will be packed full with opportunities to make lots of exciting new music in workshops and rehearsals. KNM Campus Days culminates in a concert on Saturday, in which everyone is invited to take part. There will be performances by the KNM campus ensemble and our two visiting ensembles - CoMA Allcomers and CoMA Maastricht, who we are very proud and pleased to be able to welcome to our city. Participants will perform extracts from the workshops and all the players will come together to perform Hannah Kendall's work *Into Pieces* directed by CoMA's conductor Gregory Rose.
